I have always heard 1.5 times the depth. Unless the fly is heavily weighted, it is unlikely ever to hang straight down below the indicator. You can catch fish up in the water column, but typically a nymph should be drifting within a few inches of the bottom. Take it from me, I rarely nymph and more rarer still use a bobber.
