The spot you're fishing was also best avoided late in the afternoon as all the charter sportfishers were returning to the marina and throwing huge wakes. PS: The fish you're holding appears to be a lizardfish. They're more common in FL but they get 'em in NC too. They're notorious for aggressively hitting lures repeatedly until they are hooked and are considered pests.
