I use a pattern called the CDC and Elk for all my caddis. You can find tying instructions for it on the web. You tie in a CDC hackle by the tip and wrap for the body. Add your deer hair wing, and you're good to go. It's been one of my most effective patterns on the Wissahickon since I learned it about 10 years ago.
