I've seen his nymphing video, and he throws really long (for nymphing standards) upstream casts and has really good line control, but he keeps the rod tip high. Based on his explanation, it seemed that he achieved this by putting a lot of weight on so that even though you are placing a decent amount of tension on the line, the weight will keep you from pulling it off the bottom. It looked like he was essentially dragging the weights across the bottom. I'm probably wrong about that part, but that's what it looks like he's doing.
