I should probably clarify on the 40 footers, I only throw those sometimes, and its when I'm using a long leader in a deeper, slow moving, long run. In typical pockets and riffles I will not do this, but rather stick to a more traditional short roll cast. It's more of a prospecting cast than anything else, and I probably only throw it about 15% of the time while nymphing. I'm sure this approach is considered stupid by many, but I get a lot of fish with it, so there has to be some validity. However, its heavily dependant on a lot of mending and an indicator to show the drift, and I don't think I could pull it off without the indicator.
