I like to use long fluoro leaders, 9 to 12', and add 8 to 10" of red Amnesia as a butt section between my flyline and leader forming an indicator of sorts. Using this system I keep all of my flyline off the water, which allows me to have only the leader on the water. I then watch the lower end of the Amnesia for strikes. I am not saying this is the best method, but I feel that by having only the fluoro leader and not the floating line on the water my nymphs reach optimum depth faster and the drift is easier to control not battling any belly in the floating line. I can't take credit for the idea as it is my version of Mr. Humphry's no flyline, mono line only nymphing.
