Fished the river for a few hours yesterday below the dam. Air temps were around 28 and the water was 49. There were no midges in the air and the fish weren't taking the subsurface midge patterns all too well so I grabbed the streamer rod and started covering water. Fished bunny patterns and sculpins and both caught fish equally well. I did talk with the gentleman who takes care of the TU hatchery at the dam and he said there had been some tremendous midge hatches of late. He fished for a bit right at the outflow and had a couple of takes on midge patterns fished just below the surface.

Flows are 350 and should remain there for most of the winter barring any major weather events.
