Were you fishing the special regs area? If you fish the headwaters of Kettle and the many, many miles of tributaries, you can find some pretty good wild trout fishing.

The middle and lower sections are mostly put-and-take. That's the same situation with most of the freestone drainages in the region. You have to get up into the headwaters and tribs to find the wild trout.
