Hi SlumpBuster - Spectators are encouraged, but will be asked to keep a respectful distance so as not to interfere with the competitors, or communicate with them in any way - which is strictly against the rules. As the Sector Judge for the Little Juniata River, I'd like to offer you the "nickel tour" if you come to visit this venue during the competition. The Sector HQ will be located at the Methodist Church across the bridge from Spruce Creek Outfitters. Just come to the HQ and identify yourself as a member of this forum, and I'll do my best to make your visit a worthwhile experience. This is a very "low impact" event - there will only be around a dozen competitors fishing each Sector on each session. Other than the start and end of each session when all the controllers and competitors are together at the HQ, it will probably look like just another day of guys fishing the river - they'll just be really good at it! I'd suggest bringing a pair of binoculars along, so you don't miss anything. Each competitor will be assigned a "beat" that is approximately 170 meters long, so they'll be pretty spread out.
