I count and have come to the conclusion that people who catch more than 500 trout/year are either liars or are way better than me at it.

I only did it once, a few years back. But its not that they're better than you. Just a different type of fishin. Total yearly fish is a more reliable indicator of the type of places you fish and how often you fish than an indicator of skill. 20-30 fish days add up real quick, and thats an average brookie day in June, but almost unheard of on a limestoner.

Last year I did 5 straight full days of fishing and averaged just under 40 per day. Anyone could have done it, it was easy. But thats how you rack up totals in a hurry. It makes up for an awful lot of 3 fish days on limestoners.
