I think this depends on the fishing pressure a particular stream receives. Wild fish wise-up to bright beadheads after being duped a few dozen times :).

But the reasons for using a bead are still valid...the fish are still attracted to a bit of flash and the fly traveling at a greater depth.

I now use a black tungsten bead and rib my nymphs with crystal flash to provide weight and sparkle.

works for me.
