Unless, you really don't want to get it loosened up so you have no other choice than to buy another rod..:), take one of the Liquid Wrench/penetrant type products and spray it good all around and then tap it lightly a few times with a wrench or some other metal implement. Wait a few minutes and then wrap an old sock or a cloth around the stuck nut and grab hold of it with a pair of pliers or crescent wrench and turn it slowly. I bet it'll come..

But after all that effort, you probably should treat yourself to a new rod anyway..
