Welcome aboard! Fishing from a boat I would try a bead head or weighted nymph fished on an indicator. Start fishing your fly a few feet down and keep moving the Indy up to get a little deeper until you find fish.

You may also want to try a weighted streamer or wooly bugger (white is a good minnow imitation). Cast out and count down to allow it to sink and strip it back slowly.

Be careful casting in a boat though, pinching down the barbs on your fly would be much appreciated by the fish...and your fishing partner. 😊
