The stops are important. I'm pretty aggressive with both back casts and forward casts. The "snap" happens if you come forward to early, not necessarily too hard. Hard back, stop!, wait, wait, hard forward, stop!, wait, drop.

Yep... this is what I mean by too aggressive..... not waiting and coming forward hard and fast. Crack - there goes a \$2 fly or half hour of work tying one.... Maybe aggressive was the wrong word 'cuz you do have to get after it a bit to load the rod and cast the line.
