David,

I have only used it once so far this season, not much dry fly action but it's heating up. I really like the slow action of the rod and the single foot guides work well. Which of his rods do you have?

I have and 7'6" 3 wt 36t for a brookie rod and a 9' 5wt 357.

The 36t is a great action for tight streams and fighting little brookies. I don't think he is making them anymore.

The 357 is a very fast rod that I use for big water like the yough, pine, or the clarion. Casts a mile and handles dries just as well as weighted nymphs and streamers.
