The 3rd edition has a few more streams added, but I like the 2nd edition because it has the hatches for each stream listed by date range. For example it says:

Best times to Fish:

May 10-May 31

march browns	12-14 afternoon, evening
sulphurs	14-16 evening
green drakes	8-12 evening
Olive Caddis	14-18 morning
Tan Caddis	14-18 morning

This was replaced with Meck's personal rating of streams (1 to 4 stars) in the third edition. The 3rd edition is good for leisure reading. The 2nd edition is good for planning and taking along on fishing trips. Thats my 0.02.
