If I'm picturing it correctly, you were on the wrong side of the river if you were after trout... this time of year anyway. The side you were on is great for smallmouth, but the Castleman R dumps in warm water just a mile below the dam. One side can be in the 50s while the other is in the 80s. It can take a few miles for it to mix before the trout spread out across the river again.

Regardless, streamers are a good bet for that river... especially in the summer when smallies are active and trout are in chase mode.
