You'll figure it out in the first couple minutes, but I'd say it's more of a means for transport and throwing streamers is easier than nymphing or dry fly fishing. Still not an ideal way to fish. I wouldn't do it in the runs, but when you're just floating through dead water it's a good way to keep your line in the water. If you want to fish runs or riffles, get out and do it or you'll just end up spinning around, grabbing for the oars with line everywhere or running into stuff.

If you have one where you can stand up, I'd say it'd be a good way to anchor and nymph or throw dries in areas that are tough to wade.
