Jay,

It is easy once you get the hang of pointing the boat in the right direction and keeping the line out from under the boat. I had Brandon and Alpa nymphing while floating through runs and we all had success doing it. You keep the one oar up and use the off hand to steer or manage your direction. Keep about 20-25' of line out and hit every seam and dead spot you can as you go through the section. No false casting. Pick it up and slap it down. I think we hooked more while drifting than we did while wading. I'll show you. Alpa wasn't digging it at first but warmed up to it pretty quickly. It'll take you a few floats to figure out where you want to put everything and how to best guide the boat / cast.
