Don't know if you guys do this or not, but a neat trick I picked up is to run a length of nylon rope with a dog leash type latch on each end, from the front of your pontoons. My ST has rings on the front of the 'toons that work great for this. When you can stand up after hooking a fish, the boat can't drift away - the rope hits your legs and the boat stays with you. I keep the length of the rope fairly taught between the 'toons to avoid getting it caught on stuff while drifting. Works great to secure the boat to streamside brush when you want to get out and wade, too.
