Man there's a lot of good input on this subject. I love the pictures and advice afishinado. I never thought about the tapered leader having so much of an effect on drag. I knew the water on top was faster than the water on the bottom but that's about it. I overheard someone in a fly shop telling a guy to use 4' of 5x tippet to help the nymphs sink faster but didn't think about the drag. I've been trying to use a check nymphing approach more because I don't like to use indicators but I just came accross one called a "fish pimp" that's super easy to put on and adjust and it even casts well. That little tidbit about "checking" the indicator that pcray explained sounds like a winner. I just hope I remember to try it out the next time I'm on the water.
