Bam,

The Casselman is putting very little water into the mix right now so that really isn't the issue. GG is right in that the lake runs out of cold water this time of year so it the temps at the dam are often warmer than what you will find downriver. You will see that become more and more apparent as fall approaches. The lake temp takes a lot longer to cool than the river down below, so very often, by late September, you'll see trout friendly temps in Connellsville but 70 degree water below the dam. Even weirder, the C-man will soon become colder than the Yough. It's a strange deal.
