spey casting is great if you are tight to the bank and want to fish out passed 50 ft...useing the double spey cast you can fish a lot of water from one place...check out some of the spey sites...even here on pine a small 12'6" for a 6wt would work wonders on skiddering caddis dries...right now the october caddis is coming off a size 10 fly skiddered across the surface is a killer on trout and bass..using a spey to control the fly would be alot better than a standard rod of 9 or 10 ft..once you try , you'll find out much easier it is to fish...
