Following up on what Padraic said, for emphasis, a shorter leader will be easier to lay out properly, but not too short that it isn't an effective disguise of your presence. As a relative beginner, I would stay with leaders of about 7.5-9 feet. With an 8.5 rod, you might want to consider keeping the leader shorter than 8.5 just so you

aren't constantly getting the line/leader junction snagged in your tiptop while landing fish.
