hey jayl, fishing with a fly rod can be very slow there. i usually stop there when i don't have time for a full outing, after work etc.

you can catch a few smallies anywhere from locust street to the art museum. across the river from the art museum at the falls can be pretty hot. just throw a classic streamer into the faster water and you could catch crappies, walleye, bass, perch etc.

you could lock your bike to the guard rail at the falls and go down on to the rocks.

at any of the bridges walnut, chestnut, market, jfk etc, you can watch for what looks like a rise, but is really a bait fish jumping out of the water to escape stripers. toss a bucktail, clouser, deciever etc. in there and you could get a hook up. you could actually catch the baitfish on small bead heads with holographic tinsel bodies. i think the baitfish is some kind of herring or alewife or something.
