Dams are going to come down because of economic reasons regardless of the environmental effects. Most dams have outlived their economic purpose and the current owners probably can't pay for dam upgrades when they require it. Dams have finite lives too. Most dams around me seem to be 1920's upgrades of earlier dams - very few are the colonial originals.
