But then I'd need a different box for the next outing, etc. Instead of messin around and changing, I ended up carrying a bunch of boxes. Then you had to fish for them in pockets and such and find the right one. Much easier to just have them all in one place. When you get a chance to get out, no messin around, just grab and go.

For my trays:

Outer tray: top is a leader wallet. Bottom I have caddis. Dries, emergers, wets, nymphs. Scuds are also on this tray.

Middle tray: Mayflies. Nymphs, as well as the tiny dries on top. Bottom has dries/emergers/wets separated by species and type of fly.

Inside tray: Top has terrestrials, attractors, and egg flies. Bottom has the big flies. Streamers, big stonefly nymphs, etc.
