I agree, it's too much work and the chances of landing bigger ones like that are slim. I don't care who you are. Take a plugin rod and enjoy yourself. You'll get in 50x more casts and catch WAY more fish.

As far as taking advantage of the salt, Jersey is marginal. If you really want to get into consistent fishing you need to head north where the fish stay. In Jersey they just pass through for the most part. It's great if your a local and can be there. Otherwise your just hoping the stripers will be there when you take your trip.
