Try some small egg patterns or a pink san juan worm. I don't know if Pine gets the little black stonefly, but if it does a small black stonefly nymph (maybe size 16) can work as can a dry if you see fish rising. If you don't have a specific imitation for the little black stone fly, a black caddis in the appropriate sized will do in a pinch. Size 16-18 for the dry. My best success comes from skittering the dry on the surface.
