Sulphur Vis-a-Dun

Hook: standard dry fly #14-18 ( submitted will be on #14 JS 105's)

Thread: Light Cahill 8/0 UNI thread

Tail: Light Dun hackle barbs

Wing: Dun Poly yarn ( I use Niche products siliconized poly yarn)

Body: Sulphur Orange Superfine dubbing

Hackle: Light Dun

Sulphur Spinner

Hook: Standard dry fly #14-18 (submitted will be on #14 JS 105's)

Thread: Light Cahill 8/0 UNI thread

Tail: 4 Dun Microfiblets, divided

Abdomen: Sulphur Orange turkey boit

Wing: Dun Poly yarn (Niche Products siliconized poly yarn)


Thorax: Sulphur Orange Superfine dubbing

These, along with a Sulphur sparkle dun and a sulphur parachute, are my go-to dries during the sulphur hatch. I've chosen #14 as that's the most prominent size for sulphurs on my local waters here in NEPA.


Note: the spinner in the picture has hackle barbs for the tail, but the submitted ones will have microfiblett tails.
