I commented earlier in the thread about how there are huge differences in the sulphur patterns I have researched. I have tied up two very different ones, and would love to get some feedback.

The first one is a dark sulphur emerger, lemon wood duck tail, rusty antron and mahogany dubbed body with olive thread rib, natural dun CDC puff wing and dubbed thorax.

The second one is mallard flank tail, a blend of yellow and orange sulphur dubbed body, light cahill dubbed thorax, and light dun CDC wing.
