I'm on my third year with my Simms "Headwaters" waisthighs. They have never leaked and I wear them quite a bit and do a good amount of walking. I did send them back to the company to get the gravel guards replaced. I had wore holes in them from use. They replaced the guards and booties and checked over the entire wader! They repaired several pin holes I didn't know were there and had them back to me two weeks from the date they received them. It cost me \$75. The waders are like new again. I would recommend Simms to anyone. I also have their "Guide" wading boots. They wear like iron. I'm on my third year on those also. I have not had any problem with the Vibram rubber soles wearing down.
