Cicada time is to the dry fly fisherman what oktoberfest is to the beer drinker. Fishing can be down right silly at times. The challenge with the cicada comes in being able to cast bigger flys accurately. You still have to place it in front of the trout, and some times that requires casting under shallow tree canopy, log jams and the like. To make it extra challenging on the vise I prefer only using natural materials-no plastics-

Brood XIX is what you are referring to.

The challenge is finding decent enough water to fish over down there-If I were to drive down for brood XIX, I would concentrate on the upper Chatooga. The Chatooga is your best bet for hooking into a big, wild, brown trout in that part of the country..Should be good time-10 hour, or so, drive, well worth it to fish over an event that only happens every 13 years or so.
