Just what ever you think fits. In the summer when I'm throwing hoppers or beetles, I'll add on a zebra midge. Sometimes an ant. If you're just prospecting, put it on a elk hair caddis. It's really up to you. Zebra midges are very versatile. You can add a little shot and get it deeper (But not enough to sink your dry) or not add weight and let it float in the film. There are endless ways to fish it. If you're attaching it to a dry fly, think of it like an accessory. Just attach it and enjoy.
