I really like the tt for its shootability. I was at a small pond doing 45 foot single handed snap T and Jump roll casts. This is on a little 7.5 foot 4 weight. The line will be perfect for rolling over heavy nymphs and weighted woolly buggers as well as streamers. The one disadvantage is It doesn't double haul very good. (I have only been at this for a little over a year.) Also it wouldn't work too good for dries where you need a delicate presentation. I read some reviews and it does reccomd lining down one weight if you have a slow action rod.

I would like your take on it....You have more experience. I think it would work great on my 8 weight for steelhead when indicator fishing w a tandem nymph setup.
