There really aren't many streams that meet my expectations. The only ones that have exceeded, really have done well by me are 1) The Susquehanna when it WAS the SUSQUEHANNA 2) the Missouri 3)Spring creek 4) Little Juniata 5) Bitterroot.

What I get a kick out of are small, unknown streams that surprise me, like the stream past my parents' house that yields 14" wild browns, and the 17" wild brown that came out of a tributary to Horse Creek.

At times, streams have been exhilarating to fish: Penns, the Gallatin, Madison, Erie Tribs. But I've had PLENTY of poor fishing on those streams as well.

On other streams, like Oil Creek, you have to know it, what to expect and understand where it fits and what it does. Without this, I'll call it "Comfort Level", it's common that expectations and fishing experience don't match.
