Just a heads up, Cherry Springs isn't that far north of there, we're talking 15 minutes between the two. It's a star gazers "dark sky" park, but the campground part is separate from the observing field. And so long as your careful to avoid the 2 star parties per year, there's almost always lots of sites available.

It's also a better location IMO. You still got the Kettle watershed close, but you're also better situated for the 1st Fork/East Fork, upper Allegheny, and W. Br. Pine drainages. It's right on the high point that separates those drainages, like a quadruple divide in the heart of Potter County trout country.

Might not be the best place to hold a large get together. But if sites fill up its a fine overflow alternate.
