Orvis fresh water rods only go to a size 6! That's the Helios and the Zero Gravity. Even the cheapo Clearwater II states that sizes 7 to 9 are for "Salt Species"

Bob Clouser, a wonderful fly fishing guide that fishes the same water I do, put such heavy lead eyes on his Clousers, he uses a 8 or 9! LOL He also targets carp when the smallmouth won't cooperate.

IMHO, that's a overkill. You can easily land any freshwater fish on a 6wt.

You can tie huge top water stuff that doesn't weigh anything.
