I usually start with a synthetic (I prefer white HiVis) for durability and ease of tying, but have recently started to use a lot more snowshoe.

HackleStacker is my "go to" pattern during a spinner fall for fussy fish.

The ParaSpinner (very similar to a fish's parachute, but with the front of the hackle clipped) has also been a great pattern for wary browns, too, and is easier/faster to tie, which can be important when you get off of the water at 11pm and need to tie a dozen in your camper for the rest of your buddies who struck out!
