Here's another vote for Shorecatch. If you're going to the Somerset show, Jim Freda and the Shorecatch guys usually have a booth. Look for the videos of blitzing fish. 😊

You're probably already aware of this but, in the event you're not, you should know that albies in the northeast are a seasonal game. For NJ, you're talking about from about Labor Day weekend until about Oct 15th. Before or after those dates makes for less probability of finding fish. NY would fall about two weeks earlier and the Outer banks in NC about two weeks later. Also, you'll want a boat guide. Albies can be caught from the beach but it is very hit or miss (mostly miss) and FFing just makes the likelihood of getting one from the sand even remoter.
