So if your right, I have the genus correct, but the species wrong, which is common with me. If so, the common name is Cream Cahill, not March Brown. Would help explain the timing and size. The brownish color threw me for a loop I guess, but individuals vary so much.

Still unsure, though. Just pretty sure on the *Maccaffertium* genus, which covers March Browns and a bunch of other species commonly called cahills (light cahills, cream cahills, etc.)
