I learned plenty about this last year with a couple of my fishing buddies. My 1st time out I was skunked. 2nd time I caught and landed 3. My advice is simple:

First you need to spot them feeding (look for smoke trails).

Once you find a feeding fish just cast about 5-6 feet in front of the fish and let your fly sink and rest on the bottom for a minute. Have patience.

Once the carp is close enough to the fly start stripping in short and slow strips pausing a bit in between. Have patience.

When they grab it, hang on and have fun!!

I use the backstabber fly last year with great results.
