I use the furlled mono leaders from feather -craft for 98% of my fishing, including saltwater. I tie my own leaders for streamers and steelheads. They have a cool little metal O-ring to which you tie your tippet material. They float high, don't spray and I can turn over as much as 5 ft of tippet. I normally use the 6' length with 3 ft of tippet or for ultra spooky fish, the 9 ft length w/ 4 or 5 feet of tippet. They are a little expensive, but they last for seasons. I have furlled leaders I have been using for 3 years with plenty of use left. The price is around \$15, but if you get 4 or 5 years from them it is cost effective, perhaps more so than tying your own. Just a thought.
