I see you put a tail on it. I don't - since midges don't have tails. It really doesn't matter that much though IMO.

I should also add that they can be tied with a parachute hackle wound around the post. I used to tie them that way. However, winding a parachute on a fly that small can be frustrating. And I found that the flies tied without one seem to float and work just as well for me.

You also talked about fishing a white midge - on penns I believe.

Just tie the same pattern - but with light gray thread for the body - for it. I've come across both white and black midges on limestone streams.
