question? I was out last week and saw some tiny BWO's. I put on a BWO dry size 18 or 20. on the hook i added a caddis larva size 20. i could not get the larva down with out sinking the BWO Dry. what is the trick on getting the Larva down without sinking the dry. I did use gink and when that didn't work also tried the powder to keep it afloat. i also tried to put some xink on the larva and could not get it to sink without sinking the dry. yes, the fly did float when it was just the dry and larva but the larva took to long to sink. I just wrote all this trying to give you an idea of what i tried with no success.

It doesn't take a lot to sink a size 20 BWO, so it may not be your best choice to use as an indicator for a fly of the same size.
