River conditions were decent with flows around 5000 cfs out of the dam and weather was cold. However one of our clients joined us for the afternoon on Saturday and we guided him to his first ever Musky on the Fly. 42"er's. It was a perfect way to break in the new craft. Sunday we floated again but only managed a few small trout 16-18"ers. Bright sun, high 60's air temp and alot of jet boat traffic may have hampered the fishing somewhat.
