Well, here's what we know:

- Cold front coming through. Everyone gets a little rain, but it's more like a line of rain, not an all day type of thing. Time frame of Saturday daytime for western PA, and Saturday evening through the overnight for eastern PA. Amount of rain uncertain, but not a gully washer. If it's more the thunderstorm type, it could be hit and miss too, perhaps giving someone a half inch but completely missing somewhere not far away.

- Sunday cool and non-rainy.

- Monday is the question mark. Major storm coming up the coast. Would enter the area after midnight Sunday night and depart Sunday evening. Sharp cutoff, meaning there's a north/south line. East of it gets extended, driving, nonstop cold rain that's going to lay down a lot of water. West of it gets nothing or just a light shower or two. That line could set up anywhere from the Ohio border over to the Jersey shore (as in the beach, not the town).

This storm will also cause a snowstorm on the NW fringes. Perhaps enough for decent accumulations. Depending on that path, it could be the Adirondaks, Vermont, etc. Or if a more western track, finger lakes region and some of it could sneak down into the northern portion of our state along the NY border somewhere.
