Getting Ephemerellids to genus can be tough at times especially females. I can't see some important characters from your photographs. There is a lot of variation in *E. subvaria*, but a size 16 is pretty small for one. But it's certainly possible, eye color doesn't look right to me for it to be *Eurylophella* and it's a little early for them as well but this year being what it is anything is possible as far as emergence dates go. *D. cornuta* would be early as well and the tails are wrong.
