FCP is right on the money. Typically with BM or other bottom release only reservoirs with a limited coldwater pool, when one can reduce the high volume releases, the cooler water will last longer.

Also, last August the rains came on strong and the Corps did start to ramp up releases to around 300-400 cfs. That will drain what's left of the cool water pretty quick.

Afish, look at the historical CFS chart and the cool water starts to run out when the Corps increases the releases. Coincidence?

Regardless, BM is limited in the cold/cool water department. Typically, it will run out of cool water around early August. Sometimes sooner, sometimes later in the month.
