There are large brown wooden signs on both the Willowemoc and Beaverkill indicating the beginning point and end point for the No Kill sections. As I said earlier there is one section on the Willowemoc starting a bit below the museum and continuing down stream to a point below an iron bridge that is behind Harry Darbee's home.

There are two on the BK and both are clearly marked. The non resident fishing license costs \$70.00. They do not accept credit cards or checks. You must pay for it with cash. There are a couple of motels in Roscoe, The Roscoe Motel is right at the confluence of the upper Beaverkill and the Willowemoc. There is another place called the Baxter House. You can find good food at the Roscoe Diner and there is a good Italian restaurant on the corner of Main St and old Rte 17.

As JeffK mentioned it is illegal to fish the Beaverkill or Willowemoc after September 30 unless you are fishing in a desinated C&R section. You can fish the WB of the Delaware border waters legally until October 15 as long as one side of the river is PA. Once you get about a mile above what is called Upper Game Lands both banks are in NYS and no fishing is allowed.
